4 - Let's talk about Sunday's sermon

Pastor Giuseppe preached on 9/15 about Jesus healing a demonpossessed man. Let's talk about it...

- Read Mark 5:1-20
- Mark is writing down the stories that the disciple Peter had witnessed. What message does Mark want us to understand from this story?
- At the end of the story, the healed man shares with others what Jesus had done for him. What stories can we share from our lives?
- This story is quite dramatic, but maybe you know someone you can be praying for God to bring healing into their life.
