Pastor Scott shared a variety of the beliefs people in the Ancient and Modern world have had about Jesus, including some of the common LDS teachings about Jesus that veer from Scripture.

- Have you heard some of these ideas about Jesus? What are your thoughts?
- Let's discuss it! We'll be talking about the second section of **The Apostle's Creed** about Jesus for the next two weeks...

God wants us to know Him and walk in relationship with Him

- God relates to us as Son a term of relationship and family
- Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-21:
 - Paul says that through Christ we have entered the New Creation what does that say to you that you are part of God's new work?
 - Paul tells us, "God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself" how do you understand this idea of God in Christ?
 - **The Great Exchange** "God made Him who knew no sin to become sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of Christ" what an exchange! Jesus was sinless, but took my sin I was a sinner, but have been give the righteousness of Jesus. Share what that means to you!

• Read Romans 10:9-13:

- What does it mean for us in our world to declare with our mouth that Jesus is Lord?
- Is it hard for you to beileve that God raised Jesus from the dead?
- Now Read on to Romans 10:14-17:
- Both Romans 10 and 2 Corinthians 5 tell us that we are ambassadors for Christ, proclaiming the Truth about Jesus to our world. How do these passages speak to you - how can your words and life be a proclamation that "Jesus is Lord"?

Read The Apostle's Creed together:
